- Groups run by and for black and minority ethnic people, and/or
- Groups run by and for disabled people.

How we can help member groups

We can help member groups in a lot of different ways. We can:

- Help new groups to draft a constitution and open a bank account
- Design and print leaflets, posters and stationery
- Help you to raise money for your group
- Help you to learn how to keep your accounts
- Help you to write letters and emails
- Help new committees to get started, with short, informal introductory sessions on the role of Chair, Secretary and Treasurer
- Provide independent examinations of your accounts
- Provide ongoing one-to-one support to help your committee to develop skills in:
 - ◊ chairing meetings
 - ◊ taking minutes
 - ◊ keeping accounts
 - ◊ fundraising
- Support your committee to work well together, with support and advice about how to run good meetings, spread responsibilities and communicate well
